### FAITH-BASED DISASTER RELIEF PARTNERSHIP ROLLS OUT OF SKID ROW TO LOUISIANA TO TAKE FOOD, WATER, BLANKETS, BABY DIAPERS AND OTHER SURVIVAL NECESSITIES TO VICTIMS OF HURRICANES

Hope and help are literally on their way to victims of Hurricane Gustav. Willie and Tom Jordan of Fred Jordan Missions, Jack Hibbs, Senior Pastor of Calvary Chapel Chino Hills; Tony Perkins, President of Family Research Council and Mark Bergman of the Bergman Companies joined together to answer the call from Louisiana's Governor for more food and water by packing and driving over half a million food items, 170,000 bottles of water, 1,000 blankets and 1,000 boxes of diapers to victims of the Hurricanes in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. Thousands of Boxes of Hope filled with necessities for survival are being delivered directly to those who need it most.

This isn't the first time Fred Jordan Missions has brought hope and healing to disaster survivors who find themselves destitute through no fault of their own. Three years ago the Mission reached out to victims of Hurricane Katrina by providing funds for food and shelter for thousands. The Mission "adopted" displaced men into their family by providing homes for them at the Mission where they had access to hot and healthy meals daily; warm beds and hot showers; new clothes; career counseling and job referrals; health referrals and grief counseling

The Mission has fed, clothed and sheltered our community's neediest citizens since 1944. Throughout the year, the Mission feeds hundreds of hungry people every day and with the assistance of compassionate donors, volunteers and staff, builds schools, orphanages and hospitals around the world, distributes food and clothing to the homeless, and makes every holiday special for poor families. We bring badly needed food and clothing to crime-ridden inner cities and provide nutritious meals and after-school education for at-risk children.

The Mission is a non-profit, faith-based, educational and relief organization meeting the needs of hungry, homeless and impoverished people, especially children and families in the inner cities of America and around the world.
